

STATE SINKING FUND.

No. 37 of 1955.

AN ACT to amend the *State Sinking Fund Act 1929*, the *Public Works Execution Act 1934*, the *Public Works Execution Act (No. 2) 1934* and the *Public Works Execution Act 1935*.

[3 November, 1955.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *State Sinking Fund Act 1955*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *State Sinking Fund Act 1929*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section thirteen of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

“13.—(1) On the first day of July in each year, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, the Commissioners— Sinking fund for returned soldier settlement leases.

I Shall make such provision as they consider necessary for payment to be made as provided by section twelve: and

II May, subject to that provision, pay to the Treasurer any moneys standing to the credit of the special fund constituted under that section.

(2) All moneys received by the Treasurer under this section shall be applied towards meeting the losses incurred by the State in connection with the settlement of returned soldiers under the *Returned Soldiers' Settlement Act 1916* or the *Closer Settlement Act 1929* or in connection with the settlement of settlers under the *War Service Land Settlement Act 1950*.”

3—(1) The enactments specified in the schedule are repealed. Abolition of certain sinking funds.

(2) The Commissioners shall pay to the Treasurer all moneys held by them in accordance with the enactments repealed by this section.

ANIMALS AND BIRDS PROTECTION.

No. 38 of 1955.

AN ACT to amend the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1928*.
 [3 November, 1955.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1955*.

(2) The *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1928*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph II of subsection (2) the word “nine” and substituting therefor the word “ten”; and
- (b) by omitting sub-paragraph (g) of that paragraph and substituting therefor the following sub-paragraph:—

“(g) Two shall be such persons as the Governor determines, including an officer of the Department of Agriculture:”.
