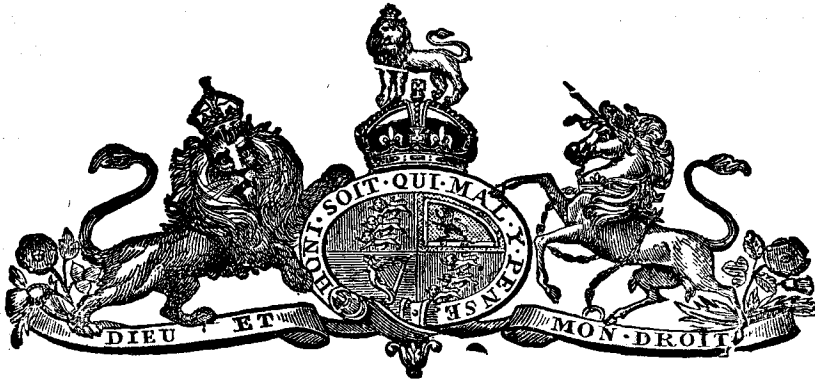

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Works in connection with the Provision by the State of Accommodation Houses for Tourists. [19 August, 1935.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *State Tourist Accommodation Houses Execution Act 1935*. Short title.

2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the first schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amount specified in that schedule in respect thereof.

3 The Treasurer may, for the purpose of defraying the costs of the works authorised by this Act—

- i. Raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of two hundred and fifteen pounds three shillings and four pence : and
- ii. Reappropriate the sums specified in the second schedule, amounting in the aggregate to fifteen pounds sixteen shillings and eight pence.

3. Amount required to recoup lessee of Lake Leake Accommodation House for provision of dairy, staff-room, and additional stove	75
