AN ACT to amend the Shop Trading Hours Act 1984 [Royal Assent 29 April 1992]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Shop Trading Hours Amendment Act 1992.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on 30 April 1992, but if it has not received the Royal Assent before that date, it is taken to have commenced on 30 April 1992.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Shop Trading Hours Act 1984* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 5A amended (Special provisions for certain shops)

- 4—Section 5A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (1A) and substituting the following subsection:—
 - (1A) Notwithstanding section 5, a shop to which that section applies which is located in the city of Burnie may be kept open from noon to 6 p.m. on 2 May 1992.
