SHOP TRADING HOURS AMENDMENT (EXTENSION OF TRADING) ACT 1993

No. 112 of 1993

AN ACT to amend the Shop Trading Hours Act 1984 [Royal Assent 23 December 1993]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Shop Trading Hours Amendment (Extension of Trading) Act 1993.

s. 2 No. 112 Shop Trading Hours Amendment (Extension of Trading)

Commencement

- 2-(1) This Act, except sections 4, 6 and 8, commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
 - (2) Sections 4, 6 and 8 commence on 1 May 1994.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Shop Trading Hours Act 1984* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 3 amended (Interpretation)

- 4—Section 3 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "prescribed Saturday" and substituting the following definition:—
 - "prescribed Saturday" means each of the following Saturdays:—
 - (a) the Saturday immediately preceding Christmas Day in any year;
 - (b) the Saturday immediately preceding the Saturday referred to in paragraph (a) in any year;
 - (c) the first Saturday of any calendar month in any year;

Section 4 amended (Shops to which section 5 applies)

5—Section 4 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "100" and substituting "250".

Section 5 amended (Certain shops prohibited from opening on certain occasions)

- 6-Section 5 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:—
 - (c) before 8 a.m., or between 6 p.m. and midnight on a prescribed Saturday, other than a prescribed Saturday that is
 - a general holiday; or (i)
 - a local holiday in the part of the State in which (ii) the shop is located or situated;

Section 5A repealed

7—Section 5A of the Principal Act is repealed.

Section 8 amended (Person not to be required to work at certain times on certain days contrary to an award or industrial agreement)

- 8—Section 8 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:—
 - (c) before 8 a.m., or between 6 p.m. and midnight on a prescribed Saturday, other than a prescribed Saturday that is
 - a general holiday; or (i)
 - a local holiday in the part of the State in which (ii) the shop is located or situated;

Expiry of amendments

9—The amendments made to the Principal Act by sections 4, 5, 6 and 8 of this Act cease to have effect on 1 May 1996 and, on and after that day, the Principal Act has effect, except as may be provided by any Act enacted after this Act, as if those sections of this Act had not been enacted.
