AN ACT to amend the *Totalisator Act 1935*.

[10 August, 1936.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Totalisator Act 1936*.

Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By inserting at the beginning of paragraph III. of subsection (3) of section five thereof, the words " Except as otherwise expressly provided ":

## II. As to section twenty thereof—

(a) By expunging paragraphs i. and ii. of subsection (2) thereof and deleting the words “in” to “respectively” (thereafter) and substituting therefor :—

“i. In the Northern Division, by the Association of persons controlling trotting in that area, and known as the Northern Tasmanian Trotting Association, in accordance with the rules adopted by that Association : and

ii. In the Southern Division, by the Commissioner.” : and

(b) By expunging subsections (7), (8), and (10) thereof and substituting for the former the following new subsection (7)—

“(7) In the event of there being only one trotting club in the southern city area, such one club may be granted licences in respect of more than twelve racing days in any one racing year” : and

III. By inserting after the word “racecourse” in the second line of paragraph iv. of subsection (1) of section twenty-five thereof the words “or on some racecourse elsewhere than in this State”.
