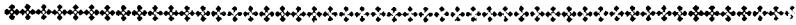

AN ACT to amend the *Totalisator Act 1935*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
 Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
 as follows:—

- 1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Totalisator Act 1945*. Short title and citation.
 (2) The *Totalisator Act 1935**, as subsequently amended,
 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

- A.D. 1945. **2** Subsection (3) of section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph I. the word "Twenty" and substituting therefor in each case the words "Twenty-four".

- 3** Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the word "three" and substituting therefor the word "six".

- 4** Subsection (1) of section ten of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the words—

- (a) "or dog" after the word "horse" in paragraph I;
 - (b) "or dogs" after the word "horses", wherever occurring, in paragraphs II. and III.; and
 - (c) "or in one race" after the words "such races" in paragraph III.
