

(2) The *Hospitals Act* 1918, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section twenty-five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (g) of subsection (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

Vacation of office by member of board.

“(g) he fails, for a period of two months or more, to attend meetings of the board without leave granted by the board, with the Minister’s approval;”.

## TRAFFIC.

### No. 35 of 1964.

AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act* 1925.  
[20 November 1964.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Act* 1964.

Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *Traffic Act* 1925, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall commence on the date on which the *Stamp Duties Act* 1964 commences.

**2** Section seventy-six of the Principal Act is amended—

Over-charging prohibited

(a) by omitting therefrom the word “No” and substituting therefor the words “Subject to subsection (2) of this section, no”; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(2) This section does not prohibit an insurer from demanding and receiving from a person by whom a policy issued in accordance with this Part is effected any sum that may be payable, by virtue of the provisions of the *Stamp Duties Act* 1931, by way of duty in respect of a certificate of insurance delivered by the insurer to that person pursuant to subsection (4) of section sixty-four of this Act.”.
