AN ACT to amend the Traffic Act 1925. [20 November 1964.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Traffic Act 1964.

- (3) This Act shall commence on the date on which the Stamp Duties Act 1964 commences.
 - 2 Section seventy-six of the Principal Act is amended— Over-charging

- (a) by omitting therefrom the word "No" and substi-prohibited tuting therefor the words "Subject to subsection (2) of this section, no"; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:-
 - "(2) This section does not prohibit an insurer from demanding and receiving from a person by whom a policy issued in accordance with this Part is effected any sum that may be payable, by virtue of the provisions of the Stamp Duties Act 1931, by way of duty in respect of a certificate of insurance delivered by the insurer to that person pursuant to subsection (4) of section sixty-four of this Act.".
