- (2) The Principal Act and this Act are, by force of this subsection, amended to such extent as may be necessary to give effect to the foregoing provisions of this section.
- (3) Subject to this section, the provisions of this Act remain in full force and effect as if this section had not been enacted.

## TRAFFIC (No. 2).

## No. 54 of 1964.

AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act* 1925. [26 November 1964.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, and citation.

- 1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Traffic Act (No. 2) 1964.
- (2) The Traffic Act 1925, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Regulations

- 2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by omitting from paragraph III of subsection (1) the words "and the granting, duration, renewal, vehicles, &c. suspension, cancellation, and return of drivers' licences,";

(b) by inserting after that paragraph the following paragraphs:-

> "IIIA Regulating the issue, variation, duration, renewal, suspension, cancellation, and return of drivers' licences:

> "IIIB Providing for the payment of a fee for the issue or renewal of a driver's licence, not exceeding in any particular case those specified in that behalf in

the second schedule:";
(c) by inserting in paragraph IV of that subsection, after the word "cancellation," (wherever occurring), the word "variation,"; and

(d) by inserting after subsection (4A) the following subsection:-

> "(4AB) Regulations made for the purposes of this section may provide that such motor vehicles and trailers as may be prescribed in the regulations shall not be required to be registered or shall not be required to be registered if they are used only for such purposes or in such circumstances or in compliance with such conditions as may be so prescribed.".

3 Section thirty-eight of the Principal Act is amended by Temporary omitting subsection (8) and substituting therefor the follow- of public ing subsection:-

- "(8) An authority shall not be given under subsection (1) of this section in respect of a street in the city of Hobart or the city of Launceston.".
- **4**—(1) On and after the date of the reprinting of the Adaptation of Principal Act this Act has effect as if from section two the to reprint symbols "III", "IIIA", "IIIB", and "IV" were omitted and of Principal the symbols "(d)", "(da)", "(db)", and "(e)", respectively, were substituted therefor and the Principal Act, as amended by this Act, has effect accordingly.
