

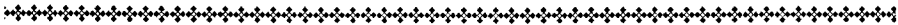


TRANSPORT (No. 2).

AN ACT to amend the *Transport Act 1938*.
[4 October 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Transport Act (No. 2)* 1973. Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *Transport Act 1938*, as subsequently amended, is referred to in this Act as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the thirtieth day of September 1972.

Appointment of
Commissioner.

2 Section four of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (3) the following subsection:—

“(3A) Nothing in subsection (3) of this section prevents the payment to the Commissioner, in addition to his remuneration, of such other sums as the Governor may, from time to time, determine.

“(3B) Subsection (3A) of this section expires when the person who held office as Commissioner at the commencement of the *Transport Act (No. 2) 1973* ceases to hold office as such.”.

Suspension and
removal of
Commissioner.

3 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) after the word “engages” the words “without the consent of the Governor”.
