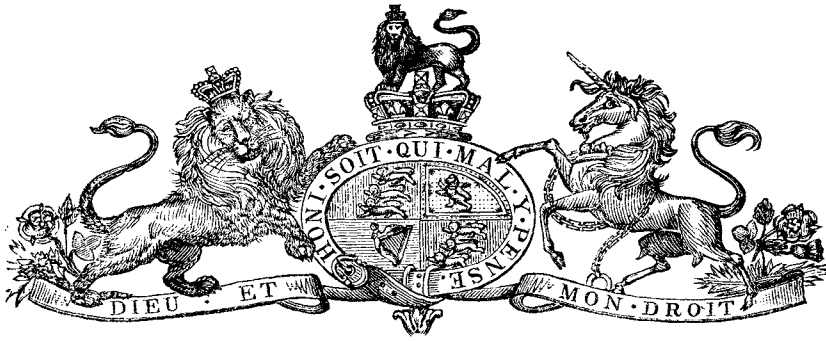

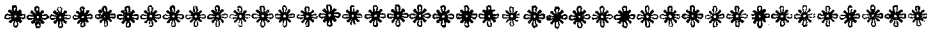

AN ACT to amend "The Audit Act, 1888." A.D. 1890.
[28 November, 1890.]

WHEREAS it is provided by Regulation Eighteen of the General Regulations in the Schedule to "The Audit Act, 1888," that "no expense, although duly provided for in the Estimates, is to be incurred by any Head of Department without the Minister's authority, either general or special" : PREAMBLE.

And whereas it is expedient and necessary to provide that such authority may be given by any Minister :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1** This Act may be cited as "The Audit Act, 1890." Short title.
- 2** In this Act the word "Minister" shall mean the Premier or any paid Minister of the Crown administering a Department. Interpretation.
- 3** The Ministerial authority referred to in Regulation Eighteen of the General Regulations contained in the Schedule (2.) of "The Audit Act, 1888," may be given by any Minister, anything contained in the said Regulation to the contrary notwithstanding. Amendment of

- 4** This Act and "The Audit Act, 1888," save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read
together.
