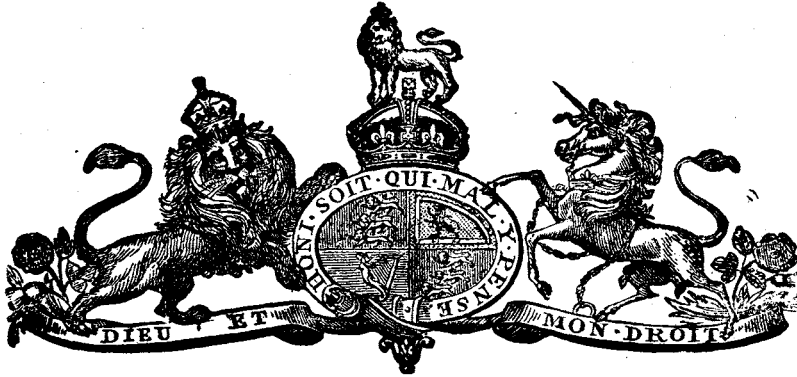

AN ACT to amend "The Agent-General's Act, 1885," in respect of the Salary payable to the Agent-General thereunder for the Year ending the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand nine hundred and ten.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Agent-General's Act, 1909," and shall be read with "The Agent-General's Act, 1885" (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act), and any amendment thereof.

2 There shall and may be appropriated, paid, and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue of the State of *Tasmania*, in respect of the financial year ending the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand nine hundred and ten, the sum of Six hundred Pounds to the Agent-General in addition to the salary of Four hundred Pounds provided by the Principal Act or any amendment thereof.
