

1. Short title and incorporation.

AN ACT to further amend "The Agent-General's Act, 1885," in respect of the Salary payable to the Agent-General thereunder for the Period commencing the First day of *July*, One thousand nine hundred and ten, and ending the Thirtieth day of *April*, One thousand nine hundred and twelve. [13 *September*, 1910.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Agent-General's Act, 1910," and shall be read with "The Agent-General's Act, 1885" (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act), and any amendment thereof.

**2** There shall and may be appropriated, paid, and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue, in respect of the period commencing on the First day of *July*, One thousand nine hundred and ten, and ending on the Thirtieth day of *April*, One thousand nine hundred and twelve, a sum at the rate of Six hundred Pounds per annum to the Agent-General in addition to the salary of Four hundred Pounds provided by the Principal Act or any amendment thereof.
