ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation.

2. Additional sum to be paid as salary of Agent-General from 1st July, 1910, to 30th April, 1912.

AN ACT to further amend "The Agent-1910. General's Act, 1885," in respect of the Salary payable to the Agent-General thereunder for the Period commencing the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and ten, and ending the Thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and twelve. [13 September, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Agent-General's Act, 1910," and Short title and shall be read with "The Agent-General's Act, 1885" (in this Act incorporation, referred to as the Principal Act), and any amendment thereof.

Agent-General Amendment.

Additional sum to be paid as salary of Agent-General from 1st July, 1910, to 30th April, 1912. 2 There shall and may be appropriated, paid, and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue in respect of the period commencing on the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and ten, and ending on the Thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and twelve, a sum at the rate of Six hundred Pounds per annum to the Agent-General in addition to the salary of Four hundred Pounds provided by the Principal Act or any amendment thereof.
