

AN ACT to grant and apply a Sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Year ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, and to appropriate the Supplies granted for such Year in this Session of the Parliament. [30 November, 1920.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, 1920-21." Short title.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and Issue and appliapply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His ca ion of Majesty for the service of the year ending the Thirtieth day of £1,575,097 10s. 8d.

Appropriation, 1920-21.

June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, the sum of One million five hundred and seventy-five thousand and ninety-seven Pounds Ten Shillings and Eightpence.

Appropriation of supplies.

3 All sums granted by this Act and "The Supply Act (No. 1), 1920-21," out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of Two million twenty-five thousand one hundred Pounds Ten Shilling and Eightpence are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of "The Supply Act (No. 1), 1920-21," for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule.

Moneys payable by warrant of the Governor. 4. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the several sums to such persons for the purposes in the said Second Schedule mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any warrant under his hand, from time to time orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in accounts.

5 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Amendment of Second Schedule of "The Appropriation Act, 1919-20." 6 The Second Schedule of "The Appropriation Act, 1919-20," is hereby amended as from the date of the passing of that Act by omitting from Item Twenty-nine in the list of items under the subheading of Grants to Medical Institutions of the heading Public Health Department the words "conditionally on the amount being repaid in Two years."
