AN ACT to amend the Traffic Act 1925.

[Royal Assent 30 November 1984]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Amendment Act 1984*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on 1st December 1984. Commencement.

Principal Act. **3**—In this Act, the *Traffic Act 1925** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 10 of Principal Act (Regulations: Application to the Crown). **4**—Section 10 (4) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “6/16th” and substituting “6/18th”.

Substitution of Schedule 2 to Principal Act. **5**—Schedule 2 to the Principal Act is repealed and the following Schedule is substituted:—

Transitional provisions.

6—(1) Where an application—
 (a) for the registration, renewal of registration, or transfer of registration of a vehicle;
 (b) for the issue or renewal of a licence; or

(c) for the issue or retention of a number-plate issued under regulations made under section 10 (1) (j) of the Principal Act,

is made on or before 1st December 1984, and the registration, or renewal or transfer of registration, or the issue or renewal of the licence, or the issue or retention of the number-plates, if done, would not be effective until that date or a later date, the fees prescribed by virtue of the substitution of Schedule 2 to the Principal Act by this Act shall have effect in relation to that application as if the fees prescribed by virtue of the substitution had taken effect.

(2) The amendment effected by section 4 of this Act shall apply in respect of amounts received by the Commission on and from 1st December 1984 for fees payable to it for the purposes referred to in section 10 (4) of the Principal Act in relation to applications referred to in subsection (1).
