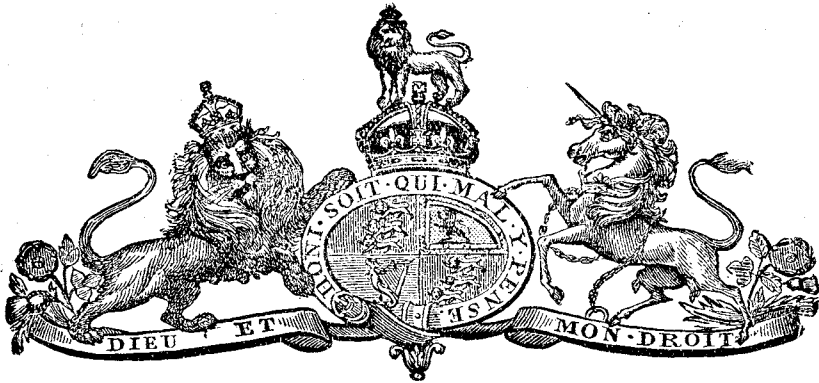

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

2 Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, for the several purposes specified in the schedule hereto, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Six thousand and fifty Pounds, but so that the amount to be appropriated, issued, and applied for each such purpose as aforesaid shall not exceed the sum set out in the said schedule in respect thereof.
