

AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums out of

the Consolidated Revenue to the Service of the State of Tasmania for the Year ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act (No. 2), Short title. 1933-34."

Appropriation of £25,259 14s. 8d.

2 There may be appropriated, issued, and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, for the several purposes specified in the schedule, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Twenty-five thousand two hundred and fifty-nine Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Eight Pence, but so that the amount to be appropriated, issued, and applied for each of the purposes so specified shall not exceed the sum set out in the schedule in respect thereof.
