AN ACT to amend "The Auction Act, 1913," and for other purposes. [4 December, 1919.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

Amendment to Section 7 of 4 Geo. V. No. 37.

2-(1) Subsection (3) of Section Seven of "The Auction Act, 1913," is hereby amended by omitting the proviso thereto and by adding at the end of the subsection the following words :—" Provided that where any licence is issued after the Thirtieth day of June in any year, the fee payable in respect thereof shall be Twenty-five Pounds for a general licence, and Ten Pounds for a hmited licence."

(2) The amendment made by this section shall have a retrospective effect as from the First day of July, 1919.
