

AN ACT to amend the Animals and Birds Protection Act, 1928. [12 January, 1931.] A.D. 1930.

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Animals and Birds Protection Act, 1930.” Short title.

**2** The Animals and Birds Protection Act, 1928, is hereby amended—

- i. By deleting the word “seven” in the first line of Subsection (3) of Section Eleven thereof and substituting therefor the word “five”;
- ii. By deleting the word “not” in the fifth line of Paragraph xiv. of Subsection (1) of Section Eighteen thereof;
- iii. By deleting from the fourth line of Subsection (3) of Section Eighteen thereof the word “Municipality” and substituting therefor the word “Municipalities”; and
- iv. By inserting after the word “Island” in the fifth line of the said Subsection (3) the words “and Flinders.”

Limitation of

**3** The provisions of Paragraphs iii. and iv. of Section Two of this Act shall expire on the Thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.
