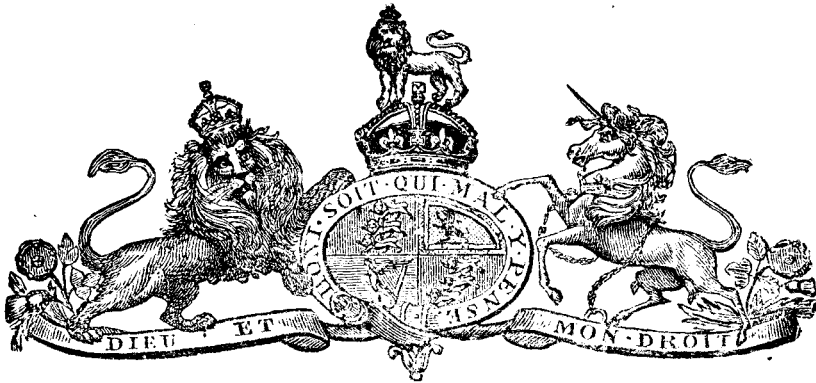

AN ACT to amend the Amusements Duties <sup>A.D.</sup> 1930.  
 Act, 1916. [6 October, 1930.] —

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Amusements Duties Act, 1930.” Short title.

**2**—(1) The Amusements Duties Act, 1916, is hereby amended by expunging the schedule thereto, and substituting therefor the following new schedule—

## “ SCHEDULE

Amusements duty shall be payable as follows :—

- |  |                |
|--|----------------|
| i. Where the payment, excluding the amount of duty, exceeds One Shilling, but does not exceed One Shilling and Sixpence .....          | Twopence       |
| ii. Where the payment, excluding the amount of duty, exceeds One Shilling and Sixpence, but does not exceed Two Shillings.....         | Threepence     |
| iii. For every additional Sixpence or fractional part of Sixpence of such payment over Two Shillings, excluding the amount of duty ... | One Half-penny |

and in cases where properly constructed barriers or mechanical contrivances which automatically register the actual number of persons admitted through or past such barriers or contrivances as a means of gaining admission to an amusement, are permitted to be used in lieu of duly stamped tickets, duty at such of the above rates as may be applicable upon the total of the returns made by the promoter of such amusement calculated as though the numbers registered had been tickets issued.”

(2) The amendment hereby made shall take effect on and from the fifteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.

**3** Section Three of the Amusements Duties Act, 1927, is hereby repealed.
