

TRAFFIC AMENDMENT (FIRE SERVICE FUNDING) ACT 1981

AN ACT to amend the Traffic Act 1925 for the purpose of providing for the payment by the Transport Commission to the Treasurer of an annual amount out of the fees received by it for the registration and renewal of the registration of motor vehicles (other than motor cycles) and for the purpose of providing for increases in those fees, being increases required in connection with the new system of funding of fire services in the State made by the Fire Service Amendment Act 1981.

[Royal Assent 15 April 1981]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Amendment* (*Fire Service* short title. *Funding*) Act 1981.

Commencement.

2-(1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Sections 4 and 5 shall commence on 1st July 1981.

(3) After the date of assent to this Act but before the date referred to in subsection (2), regulations may be made under the Principal Act as if section 5 had commenced, but those regulations do not take effect until that section commences.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Traffic Act* 1925* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 10 of Principal Act (Regulations).

4—Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the following subsections after subsection (3):—

(4) The Commission shall, in respect of each financial year, pay to the Treasurer, as and when directed by him, an amount equal to 6/16th of the total amount received during that financial year by the Commission for fees payable to it for the registration and renewal of registration of motor vehicles (other than motor cycles) pursuant to regulations made under subsection (1) (d).

(4A) The amount that the Commission is required by subsection (4) to pay in respect of each financial year is the prescribed amount within the meaning of section 77L (1) of the *Fire Service Act* 1979 that the Treasurer is required by that section to contribute, in respect of that financial year, towards the aggregate of the operating costs referred to in that section.

Amendment of Schedule 2 to *Traffic Act* 1925 (Fees in respect of motor vehicles and drivers thereof). **5**—Schedule 2 to the Principal Act is amended by omitting "10.00" from the item relating to the registration or renewal of registration under the heading "*Motor vehicle* (other than a motor cycle)—" and substituting "16.00".
