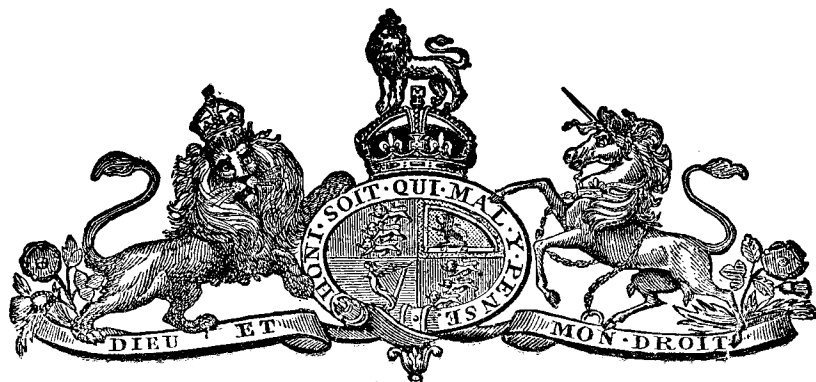

AN ACT to amend the Aid to Mining Act, 1927. [18 January, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Aid to Mining Act, 1929.”

2 The Aid to Mining Act, 1927, is hereby amended—

I. By deleting the word “one” in the first line of Subsection (2) of Section Four and substituting therefor the word “two”;

II. By expunging Paragraph 1. of Subsection (1) of Section Five and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“1. Pay or expend, or cause to be expended, in such manner and under such supervision as he may think proper, such amounts as he may think necessary for assistance to miners, tributers, leaseholders and other persons engaged in mining, for the purpose of testing or proving, by sinking, driving, or other prospecting operations, any deposit or discovery of any mining product worked or proposed to be worked by them under the provisions of the Mining Act, 1929, but the amount to be so paid or expended shall not exceed One Pound for every pound paid or expended by such miner, tributer, leaseholder, or other person engaged in mining, as the case may be:”.
