

A.D. AN ACT to regulate the Payment of certain 1906. Moneys in Aid of Road Rates in certain Road Districts. [30 November, 1906.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 This Act may be cited as "The Aid to Road Rates Act, 1906."

Short title.

2 There shall be payable by the Treasurer in the financial year Subsidy to Road ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and Districts. seven, out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, subject as hereinafter provided, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole Five thousand Pounds, for and towards the construction and repair of roads, streets, and bridges, other than main roads; and such moneys shall be payable to the Trustees of those Road Districts in which a Road Rate of not less than One Shilling in the Pound on the annual value of the property in such Road Districts shall have been made and levied in respect of the year ending on the Twenty-eighth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and seven, in amounts proportionate 4d,]

to the total sums collected in that year as the proceeds of the Road Rate or Road Rates levied in respect of that year in such Road Districts respectively: Provided that in any case where the Trustees of a Road District shall have so made and levied a Road Rate of more than One Shilling in the Pound on the annual value of the property in the Road District, their collections in excess of a One Shilling rate shall be disregarded for the purpose of this Section, and the Trustees of that District shall participate in the distribution of the aforesaid moneys on the basis of the collection by them of a One Shilling rate only; and the Auditor-General is hereby empowered to determine the amount of such collection.

No payments to be made unless Accounts, &c., forwarded to Auditor-General before certain time. **3** No subsidy shall be payable or paid under this Act to the Trustees of any Road District to which this Act applies unless the Statement and Account for the preceding year of such Trustees, as required by "The Roads Act, 1884," are forwarded to the Auditor-General before the Thirty-first day of *March*, One thousand nine hundred and seven.
