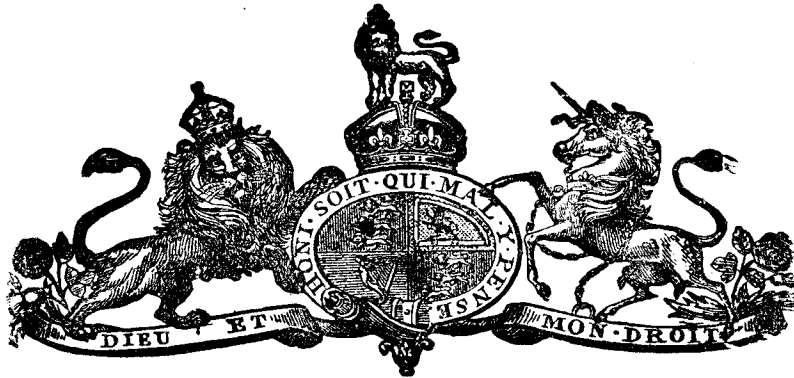

AN ACT to amend the Aid to Road Rates Act, 1924. A.D.
1927.
[16 September, 1927.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Aid to Road Rates Act, 1927.” Short title.

(2) The Aid to Road Rates Act, 1924, is herein called the Principal Act. Principal Act.

Amendment of Section 7 of the Principal Act.

2 Section Two of the Principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following section substituted therefor :—

“**2**—(1) Subsidies in aid of road rates shall be payable (except as hereinafter provided) by the Treasurer, out of moneys provided by this Act, to the councils of all municipalities constituted under the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1906, in respect of the financial year which began on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and in respect of every succeeding financial year.

(2) Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall be appropriated, issued, and applied in the financial year which began on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and in every succeeding financial year, the sum of Eleven thousand Pounds for the purposes of this Act.”

3 Paragraph III. of Section Three of the Principal Act shall not apply to subsidies to councils under that Act, in respect of the financial year which began on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.

4 Section Seven of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the words “to be” after the word “moneys” in the third line of the said section, and by deleting the words “by Parliament” in the third and fourth lines of the said section.
