AN ACT to amend the Aid to Road Rates 1928. Act, 1924. [22 December, 1928.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1-(1) This Act may be cited as "The Aid to Road Rates Short title. Act, 1928"
- (2) The Aid to Road Rates Act, 1924, is herein called "the Principal Act 15 Geo. V. No. 49. Principal Act."
- 2 Section Three of the Principal Act is hereby amended as Amendment of follows:

I. As to Paragraph I. thereof, by deleting the words "calendar Principal Act. year ending on the thirty-first day of December in such financial year" in the fourth and fifth lines thereof, and substituting; the words "immediately preceding financial year "therefor : and

II. As to Paragraph II. thereof, by deleting the words "calendar year" in the third line thereof, and substituting the words "financial year" therefor:

As to Paragraph III. thereof, by adding at the end of that

paragraph the following proviso:

"Provided that the Governor in any particular case, upon being satisfied that some special reason exists for so doing, may extend the time specified in this paragraph for such further period not exceeding three months as he may think necessary, but no such extension shall be made in any year after the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one."

Amendment of Section 4 of the Principal Act.

- 3 Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—
 - I. As to Subsection (2) thereof, by deleting the words "calendar year ending during such" in the third and fourth lines thereof, and substituting the words "immediately preceding" therefor: and
 - II. As to Subsection (3) thereof, by deleting the words "thirtieth day of June" in the second line thereof, and substituting the words "thirty-first day of December" therefor, and by deleting the words "preceding calendar year" in the fourth line thereof, and substituting the words "financial year last ended" therefor.

Subsidies payable in respect of the financial year which began on 1st July, 1927.

- 4—(1) Section Three of the Principal Act shall not apply in respect of subsidies to be paid in respect of the financial year which began on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, but subsidies shall be payable in respect of such financial year to every council which—
 - In the calendar year ended on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, levied a road rate of not less than One Shilling and Four Pence for every Pound sterling of the annual value of all properties in its municipality: or
 - 11. In the half year ended on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, levied a road rate of not less than Eightpence for every Pound sterling of such annual value as aforesaid.

Basis of calculation.

- (2) Notwithstanding anything in Section Four of the Principal Act, the subsidy payable to a council in respect of the financial year mentioned in Subsection (1) of this section shall be based upon the amount of road rate collected and expended by it on road work in the calendar year which ended on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, but in all other respects such subsidy shall be calculated in accordance with the provisions of Section Four aforesaid.
- (3) This section shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.
