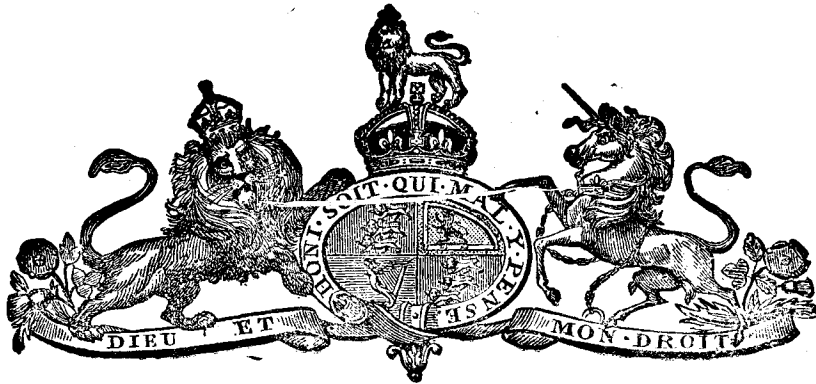

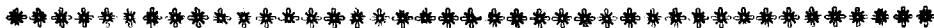

AN ACT to amend "The Bursaries Act, <sup>A.D.</sup> 1922.  
1915." [14 February, 1922.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Bursaries Act, 1922." Short title.
  - (2) "The Bursaries Act, 1915," is herein called "the Principal Act." Principal Act.

Amendment of  
Section 14 of  
Principal Act.**2** Section Fourteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

- i.—(a) By inserting the word “senior” after the word “every” in the First line of Subsection (2) thereof;
- (b) By adding after the word “years” at the end of such First line as aforesaid the words “and every Junior Bursary for a period of Three years from the date of award”;
- (c) By deleting the words “Senior Public” from the Seventh line of Subsection (2), and substituting therefor the word “Leaving”;
- ii. By deleting the word “Fourteen” from Paragraph i. of Subsection (3), and substituting therefor the word “Thirteen”;
- iii.—(a) By deleting the words “Junior Public” from the Second line of Paragraph ii. of Subsection (4), and substituting therefor the word “Intermediate”;
- (b) By deleting the word “Nine” from the Eleventh line of the last mentioned paragraph, and substituting therefor the word “Eight.”

Amendment of  
Section 20 of  
Principal Act.**3** Section Twenty of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words “Junior Public” wherever the same occur, and substituting therefor the word “Intermediate.”
