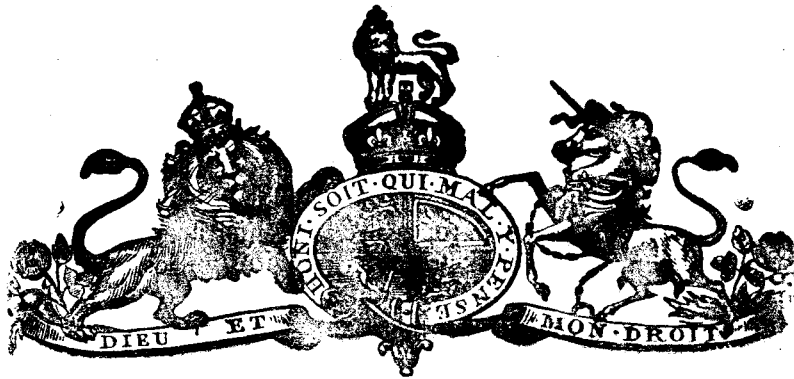

AN ACT to Authorise and Validate Payment to *Christopher Coram Spotswood* by the Beaconsfield Municipal Council of the Sum of Twenty-four Pounds. [14 October, 1918.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Beaconsfield Council Enabling Short title. Act, 1918.”

2 The Municipal Council of the Municipality of Beaconsfield is hereby authorised and empowered to pay out of its municipal fund to *Mr. Christopher Coram Spotswood*, formerly its Council Clerk, the sum of Twenty-four Pounds sterling, being Twenty-four weeks' salary due to him for services rendered as Registrar of the Courts of Request and General Sessions and Clerk of Petty Sessions, Beaconsfield, between the months of May and October, of the year One thousand nine hundred and seventeen.

made prior to

Act, same valid.

3 Should such payment as in the preceding section mentioned have been made by the said Municipal Council to *Mr. Christopher Coram Spotswood* prior to the passing of this Act, such payment is hereby declared to be and the same is legal and valid.
