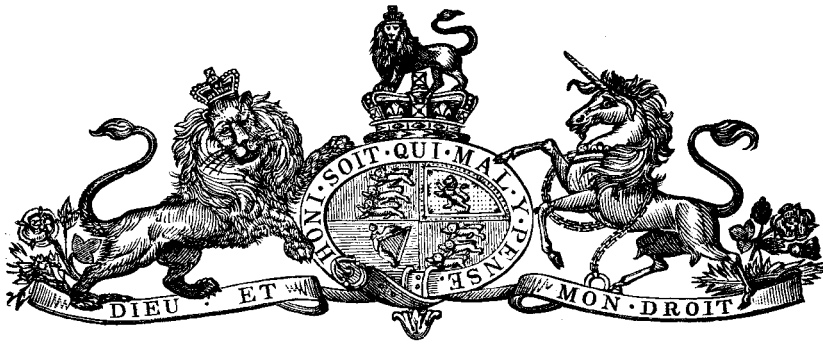

AN ACT to further amend "The Beer Duty Act, 1880." A.D. 1892.
[18 November, 1892.] —

WHEREAS it is desirable to alter the rate of Duty now imposed PREAMBLE.
by Law upon Beer brewed or manufactured in the Colony :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Beer Duty Short title.
Act, 1892."

2 This Act shall not come into operation or take effect until the Date of Act.
First day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two.

3 Section Nine of "The Beer Duty Act, 1880," is hereby repealed, Amendment of
and in lieu thereof the following shall be and be deemed to be and may Section 9 of 43
be cited as Section Nine of the said Act ; that is to say— Vict. No. 10.

"There shall be paid on all Beer brewed or manufactured within
this Colony, and sold or removed for consumption or sale, a Duty of
Four Pence per gallon, which Duty shall be paid by the brewer by
whom such Beer is made in the manner and at the time hereafter
specified."

4 This Act and "The Beer Duty Act, 1880," and every Act Acts to be read
amending the same, shall be read and construed together as one and together.
the same Act.
