

Short title. Incorporation.
 Amendment of Section 4 of Principal Act.

AN ACT to amend "The Bank Holidays Act, 1910. [20 December, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Bank Holidays Act, 1910," and Short title. shall be construed as one with "The Bank Holidays Act, 1903," in Incorporation. 3 Ed. VII. No. 4.
