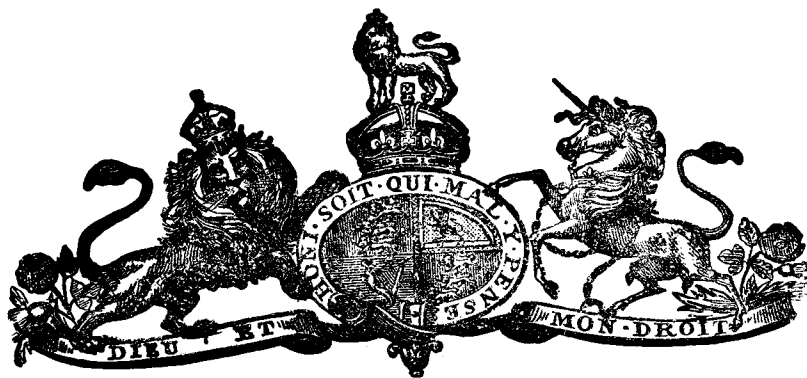

AN ACT to amend "The Bank Holidays Act, 1903." A.D.
1910.
[20 December, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Bank Holidays Act, 1910," and shall be construed as one with "The Bank Holidays Act, 1903," in his Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Bank Holidays Amendment.

Amendment of
Section 4 of
Principal Act.**2** Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

- I. As to Subsection (1.), by omitting the words “The Birthday of the Prince of Wales,” and substituting therefor the words “The Second *Monday* in *November* :”
- II. As to Subsection (2.), by inserting the word “or” after the word “*January*,” and by omitting the words “or the Birthday of the Prince of Wales.”
