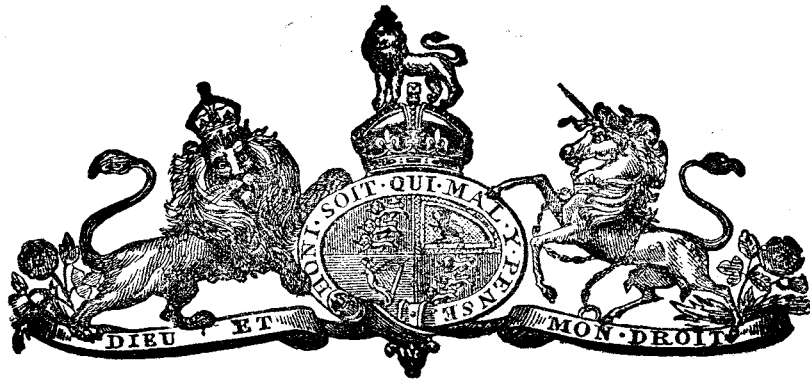

AN ACT to amend the Burnie Lighting Act, ^{A.D.} 1928.
 1911. [7 January, 1929.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Burnie Lighting Act, 1928.” Short title.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise indicates or requires, Interpretation,
 “the Principal Act” means “The Burnie Lighting Act, 1911.”

Burnie Lighting.

A.D. 1928.

Repeal and re-enactment of Section 5 of 2 Geo. V. No. 27.

3 Section Five of the Principal Act is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

“**5**—(1) The area of land included within the limits defined and set forth in Schedule (2), together with such further portion or portions of the Municipality of Emu Bay as may from time to time be added thereto or included therein as hereinafter provided, shall be and form the Lighting District.

“(2) It shall be lawful for the Council from time to time, by notice in the Gazette to add to or include in the Lighting District, as defined in the Second Schedule, any portion or portions of the Municipality of Emu Bay.”

Repeal and re-enactment of schedule.

4 Schedule (2) to the Principal Act is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

“(2)

BURNIE LIGHTING AREA.

Commence at a point on high-water mark on Bass Strait being due north of the north-eastern angle of the Quarry Reserve on the Main-road Wivenhoe southerly along the eastern boundary of the Quarry Reserve and Lot No. 4 of Section U Town of Wivenhoe thence by the southern boundary of that lot to its western boundary then southerly along Lot 2 of Section U Town of Wivenhoe to its south-western corner thence along the northern boundary of Section U Lots 3 and 5 to the Stowport-road thence southerly along that road to the corner of Brummell-street westerly along Brummell-street to the Emu River thence westerly along the River Emu to the Emu Bay Railway Line thence along the northern line of the railway to Romaine Creek thence southerly along that creek to its junction with Alexander Creek thence southerly along Alexander Creek to New Country-road thence across that road and going west for a distance of 14 chains thence northerly in a straight line to Lot 14 of the Van Diemen's Land Company's Emu Bay Estate thence westerly along that line to its south-western corner thence in a north-westerly direction along the southern boundary of Lot 13 to the south-east corner of Lot 11 thence in a straight line westerly to the south-east corner of Lot No. 72A thence northerly along that line to View-road thence along that road to its junction with Mooreville-road thence northerly along that road to the south-east corner of Lot No. 7A on Oldaker's Estate sub-division thence along the southern boundary of that lot to its south-west corner, thence in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of Lot No. 10 of the Van Diemen's Land Company's sub-division to a point 8 chains southerly from the Main-road thence westerly in a parallel line with the Main-road 8 chains south of that road to the western boundary of the North Ward thence southerly along that line to the south-eastern corner of land owned by J. R. Blyth thence along the southern boundary of that land to its south-western boundary thence northerly along the western boundary of J. R. Blyth's lot to Fidler-street thence along that street to the Main-road thence northerly to Bass Strait to the point of commencement.”
