

#### ANALYSIS.

Short title and incorporation with 48 Vict. No. 14.
Protection to bank paying cheque fraudulently altered

Protection to bank paying cheque fraudulently altered where drawer negligent.

AN ACT to amend "The Bills of Exchange 1909. Act, 1884." [22 December, 1909.]

B E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Bills of Exchange Amendment Short title and Act, 1909," and shall be construed as one with "The Bills of Exchange incorporation with Act, 1884" (hereinafter called the Principal Act), and every amend- 48 Vict. No. 14. ment thereof.

2 Where a bank in good faith and without negligence pays a cheque Protection to drawn on the bank by a customer of the bank, and the cheque has bank paying 4d.]

## Bills of Exchange Amendment.

cheque fraudulently altered where drawer negligent. been drawn by the customer with gross negligence, and such gross negligence has afforded facility for any fradulent alteration in the amount thereof, and the cheque has been so fraudulently altered, the bank shall not be responsible or incur any liability by reason of having paid the cheque.

The foregoing portion of this section shall be printed on or attached to the cover of every cheque-book issued by a bank after the passing

of this Act.
