AN ACT to amend "The Companies Act, 1922." [14 February, 1922.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Companies Act, 1922." Short title.

- 2 Section Fifty-one of the Principal Act is hereby amended by Amendment of Section 51 of the expunging Subsection (3) thereof,

Amendment of Section 72 of the Principal Act. Amendment of Section 264 of the Principal Act. 3 Section Seventy-two of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the figures "IV" in the Second line of Subsection (9) thereof, and substituting the figure "V" therefor.

4 Section Two hundred and sixty-four of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

I. By expunging Subsection (4) thereof, and substituting the following Subsection therefor:—

"(4) There shall be paid to the Registrar for registering any document required by this section to be filed with him a fee of Five Shillings, or such smaller fee as may be prescribed": and

11. By deleting the figure "4" in the last line of Subsection (13) thereof, and substituting the figure "5" therefor.

Amendment of Form C in the 2nd Schedule to the Principal Aco. 5 Form C in the Second Schedule to the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the word "shares," in the last line but one of the said Form, and substituting the word "affairs" therefor,
