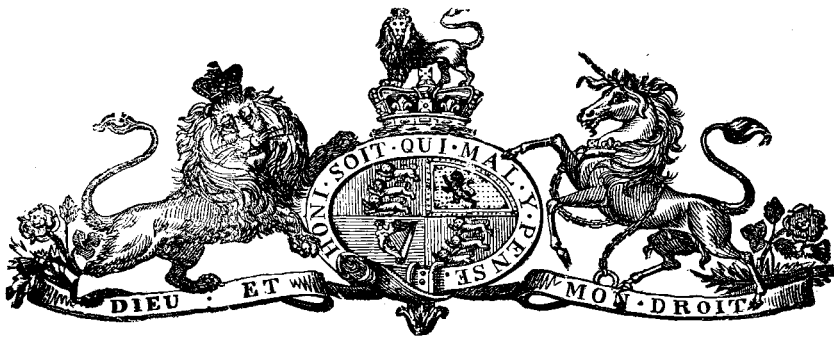

No. 1. *Amendment to the Constitution Act, 1896*

AN ACT to further amend "The Constitution A.D. 1896.
Act."

[Reserved, 23 July, 1896 ; Royal Assent proclaimed, 13 November, 1896.]

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary to further amend *The PREAMBLE.*
Constitution Act in certain particulars :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Constitution Amendment Act, Short title.
1896."

2 Section Twelve of "The Constitution Amendment Act, 1885," Repeal.
and Sections Two and Three of "The Constitution Amendment Act, 49 Vict. No. 8.
1893," are hereby repealed : Provided this repeal shall not affect any- 57 Vict. No. 9.
thing lawfully done under the authority thereof, nor any rights
acquired or liabilities incurred thereunder.

3 The House of Assembly shall consist of Thirty-seven elected House of

one years, and a natural born or naturalized subject of Her Majesty, seven Members.

4 This Act and "The Constitution Act" and every Act altering or Acts to be read
amending the same shall be read and construed together as one and together.
the same Act.
