

AN ACT to further amend The Constitution A.D. 1903. Act. 18 Vict. No. 17.

[Reserved, 10 December, 1903; Royal Assent proclaimed, 29 February, 1904.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Constitution Amendment Act, Short Title. 1903."
- 2 The word "man" in the first line of Section Three of "The Amendment of Constitution Amendment Act, 1900," is hereby expunged, and the Sect. 3 of 64 Vict. word "person" is hereby inserted in the said first line in lieu thereof.

- 3 The word "man" in the first line of Section Five of "The Constitution Amendment Act, 1900," is hereby expunged, and in lieu Sect. 5 of 64 Vict. thereof, the word "person" is hereby inserted in the said first line.



Amendment of Sect. 7 of 64 Vict. No. 5.

Acts to be read together. 18 Vict. No. 17. 4 The word "person," in Section Seven of "The Constitution Amendment Act, 1900," shall not be construed to mean female, but shall be construed to mean male only.

5 This Act, and The Constitution Act, and every Act amending the same, save as altered or amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
