AN ACT to further amend "The Customs Duties Act, 1880." [24 November, 1884.] A.D. 1884.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 On and after the First day of *November*, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-four, all Cattle and all Sheep and Lambs shall be exempt from the payment of any Customs Duties. Exemptions.

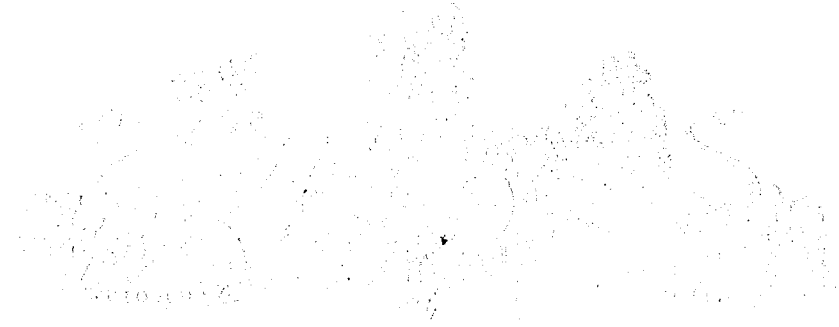
2 On and after the passing of this Act, Permanent-way Material and Rolling Stock for use on Railways or Tramways, consisting of— Rails, fish-plates and bolts, spikes or other fastenings, springs, wheels, and axles, shall be exempt from the payment of any Customs Duties. Further exemptions.

3 On and after the passing of this Act, the following words contained in the Table of Exemptions to "The Customs Duties Act, 1880," shall be struck out ; that is to say,— Railway Plant, Rolling Stock, and all material which may be applied to the construction and maintenance of Railways or Tramways, and not including Stationery or similar articles. Certain articles liable to Duties.

4 "The Customs Duties Act, 1880," and every Amendment thereof, save so far as the same may be altered by this Act, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

5 This Act may be cited as "The Customs Duties Act, 1884." Short title.
