

AN ACT to further amend "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861," and "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1901," and for other purposes.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, Short title. 1912."

2—(1) Sections One and Four of "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861," are hereby amended by omitting therefrom the words "and Strahan, and not elsewhere," and substituting in lieu of the words so

Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Amendment.

- A.D. 1912. — omitted the words "Strahan, King Island, Perkins Island, and any other place specified by the Governor in Council."
- Repeal of 58 Vict. No. 6. (2) The Act 58 Victoriae No. 6, intituled "An Act to further amend 'The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861,'" is hereby repealed.
- Amendment of 1 Ed. VII. No. 22. **3** "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1901," is hereby amended by omitting the word "cattle"—
- I. From line Seven of the definition "Disease" in Section Two: and
 - II. From Sections Four, Six, and Seven, wherever occurring therein: and
 - III. From Paragraphs xxxi. and xxxii. of Section Twelve— and substituting the word "animals" in lieu of the word "cattle" so omitted.
