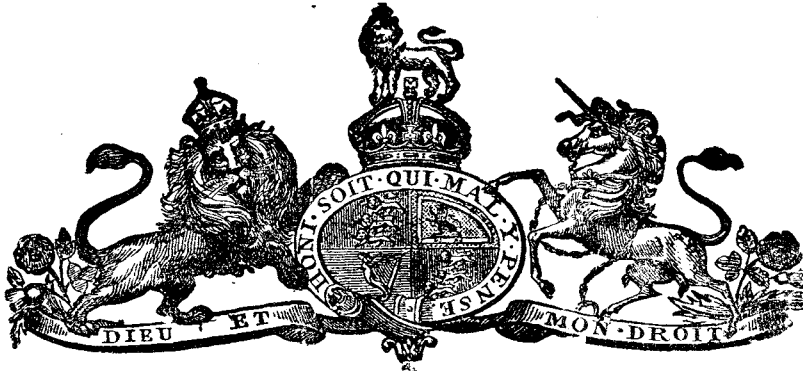

AN ACT to amend the Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861. [22 December, 1927.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Short title. Act, 1927.”

2 The enactments specified in the schedule to this Act are hereby Repeal. repealed to the extent indicated in the third column of the said schedule.

3 Section Seven of the Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1901, is hereby amended by inserting after Subsection (4) thereof the following new Subsection (5):—

“(5) All compensation payable under this Act shall be paid out of moneys from time to time provided by Parliament for that purpose.”

Closing of Fund.

4 Upon the passing of this Act the Treasurer shall cause the Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act Fund to be balanced and closed, and after payment thereof of all claims, demands, and amounts properly payable therefrom prior to this Act, shall pay the balance standing to the credit of such Fund into the Consolidated Revenue.
