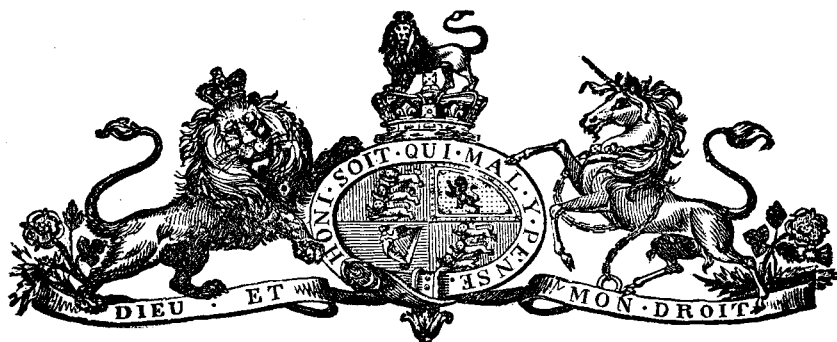

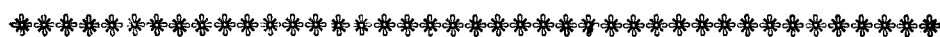

AN ACT to amend "The Customs Duties Act, 1880." [1 November, 1880.] A.D. 1880. —

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Customs Duties Act, 1880:." PREAMBLE. 43 Vict. No. 11.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Any article or thing given or awarded to any person as a prize, reward, or trophy at any public exhibition or competition held in any of the *Australasian* Colonies, and any article or thing *bonâ fide* imported for the purpose of being given or awarded to any person as a prize, reward, or trophy at any public exhibition or competition held in *Tasmania* shall be exempt from the payment of any Customs Duties: Provided that the Collector shall be satisfied that any article or thing in respect of which exemption from Customs Duty is claimed under this Section is truly such an article or thing as is hereinbefore mentioned. Certain articles exempt from Customs Duties.

2 This Act and "The Customs Duties Act, 1880," save so far as the same may be altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Customs Duties Amendment Act, 1880." Short title.
