

AN ACT to authorise the raising of Money for the Purposes of The Cemeteries Act, 1865. [18 October, 1870.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise money for the purposes of The PREAMBLE. Cemeteries Act, 1865: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the 29 Vict. No. 7. Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised Power to raise by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in money by like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the 20th Victoria, No. 9, such sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole Eight thousand Pounds as may be required for the purposes of The Cemeteries Act, 1865, and The Cemeteries Amendment Act, 1870; and such Debentures shall be redeemable in the year 1881.

2 This Act may be cited as "The Cemeteries Loans Act, 1870."
