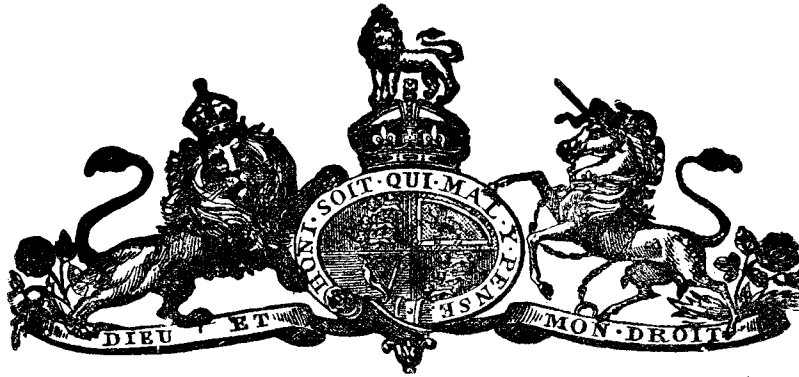

ANALYSIS.

 AN ACT to provide for the Reinstatement of certain Persons as Purchasers of certain Crown Lands, and to authorise the Governor to convey and alienate certain pieces of Land. A.D. 1930.
[23 December, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Crown Lands Purchasers Reinstatement Act, 1930.”

(2) This Act shall be incorporated with the Crown Lands Act, 1911.

Crown Lands Purchasers Reinstatement.

Interpretation.

- 2** In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—
 “The Commissioner” means the Commissioner of Crown Lands:
 “Schedule” means schedule to this Act.

Certain persons named in Schedule (2) to be permitted to complete their purchases.

Power to Latrobe Council to sell library site.

3 The Commissioner, with the consent of the Governor, may reinstate the persons named in Schedule (1) as purchasers of the several lots or areas of land set opposite to their names respectively, under the provisions of the Acts regulating the sale or disposition of Crown Lands under which the purchases of such lots or areas were made respectively; and thereupon such persons shall be liable to pay all instalments due upon such lands at the date of forfeiture and all instalments thereafter due thereon, together with the amount of fines and charges for the cost of advertising, as provided in Section Ninety-six of the Crown Lands Act, 1911, together with interest at the rate of Five Pounds per centum per annum from the dates when such instalments became due respectively.

4 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner to permit the persons named in Schedule (2) to complete the purchase of the several areas of land set opposite to their names; and upon payment of the balance of purchase-money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Twenty Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, to convey and alienate the said lands to the said persons respectively, in fee simple.

5—(1) It shall be lawful for the Council of the Municipality of Latrobe, on behalf of the Corporation of the said Municipality, and with the consent of the Commissioner, to sell the piece of land described in Schedule (3), granted to *Charles Thomas Brewer, Samuel Sternberg, and John Steer* for the purposes of a public library, and now vested in the Corporation of the said Municipality for such purposes.

(2) Upon such sale as aforesaid being effected, the grant deed in respect of the said piece of land shall be delivered up to the Commissioner to be cancelled, and thereupon the said piece of land shall revert in His Majesty, freed from all trusts affecting the same, and upon payment to the said Council of the purchase-money in respect thereof, it shall be lawful for the Governor for, and on behalf of, His Majesty, to convey and alienate the said piece of land to the purchaser in fee simple.

(3) The purchase-money for the said piece of land shall be held by the Council for the purposes of a public library for the said Municipality, and until applied for such purposes shall be invested by the Council in such manner as the Commissioner shall approve.

TOWN OF LATROBE.

SECTION V (0A. 0R. 7P.).

Bounded on the west by 1 chain northerly along land occupied by or belonging to the representatives of the late Robert Purdy commencing at the south-east angle thereof on Gilbert-street on the north by 30 links easterly along Crown land on the north-east by 57 links south-easterly along the Mersey and Deloraine Railway on the east by 47 links southerly along Crown land to Gilbert-street aforesaid and thence on the south by 50 links westerly along that street to the point of commencement.
