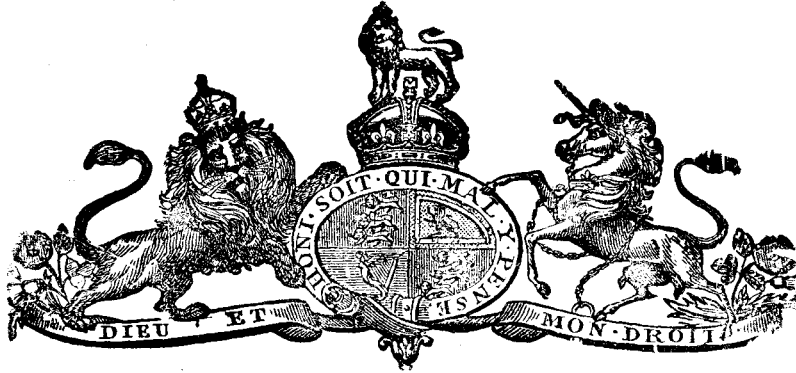

AN ACT to appropriate a certain Sum arising from the Consolidated Revenue for defraying the Costs of and incidental to the Preparation and Completion of the Draft of a Bill to establish a Code for Civil Procedure, and for other purposes. [14 January, 1925.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Civil Procedure Code Appropriation Act, 1924." Short title.

2—(1) There shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, out of the Consolidated Revenue, the sum of One thousand two hundred and fifty Pounds for the purposes expressed in the schedule to this Act.

(2) The said sum of One thousand two hundred and fifty Pounds shall be paid into and credited forthwith by the Treasurer of Tasmania to a separate account in the books of the Treasury, to be called "The Special Appropriation, 1924-25, Trust Fund," in this Act referred to as "the said fund"

3 The Treasurer is hereby authorised and empowered to issue and apply the moneys so paid into the said fund as aforesaid for the purposes set forth in the said schedule.

4 The said fund shall be available to satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor in respect of the purposes set forth in the said schedule.

5 The Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts, relating to the said fund, for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the Treasurer in passing the said accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

6 It shall be lawful for the Attorney-General to cause to be undertaken, completed, and carried out the work and objects mentioned in the said schedule at a cost therefor not exceeding in the whole the amount mentioned therein.

7 The accounts of the said fund shall be subject to the provisions of "The Audit Act, 1918," so far as such provisions are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act.

SCHEDULE.

The preparation and completion, by some legal practitioner of high standing and varied experience, in this or some other State, of the draft of a Bill to provide for uniform procedure in all civil courts; the obtaining from such practitioner advice as to amendments in the existing Statute law which would be rendered necessary consequent on the passing of such Bill; and the carrying out of all other matters in connection with or incidental to the matters aforesaid
