

### AN ACT to establish a Consolidated Revenue A.D. 1873. [31 October, 1873.] Fund.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient to abolish the distinction PREAMBLE. existing between the General Revenue Fund and "The Land Fund" of the Colony of Tasmania, and to establish one Fund to be called "The Consolidated Revenue Fund:"

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1 The Land Fund Act shall be repealed on and after the First day Repeal of 21 Vict. No. 8. of January, 1874.
- 2 On and after the First day of January, 1874, the gross proceeds of of every source of Revenue, whether General or Territorial, of the Colony of Tasmania shall form one Fund, to be called "The Consolidated Revenue Fund;" and the unexpended balances which may be to the credit of the General and Territorial Revenues upon that day shall be transferred to and become part of the said Fund.

3 The Colonial Treasurer shall cause separate entries to be made in Treasurer to keep the Books kept in his Office of all moneys received on account of the separate entries of sale of all Waste Lands of the Crown, and all rents, fees, and sums of from Waste Lands.

#### Consolidated Revenue Fund Act.

#### A.D. 1873.

Public Debt to be charged upon Consolidated Revenue Fund. 4 The Consolidated Revenue Fund shall be charged with the whole amount of the Public Debt of the Colony incurred, or lawfully authorised to be incurred, before the commencement of this Act, and the Interest thereof accruing due from time to time, and with the payment of all Debentures and other securities representing such Debt, and of all Interest thereon.

Payment of sums charged upon General Revenue and Land Fund before 31 Dec. 1873.

Provisions of 22 Vict. No. 6, to be applicable.

- 5 All sums of money charged upon and payable out of the General Revenue or the Land Fund on the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1873, and then remaining unpaid, shall thereafter be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.
- 6 All the provisions contained in *The Audit Act* shall be applicable to "The Consolidated Revenue Fund" as fully in all respects as if the same had been mentioned in the said Act instead of "The Public Revenue" or any branch thereof, or "The General Revenue," or "The Land Fund."

Short Title.

- 7 Where in any Act "The General Revenue" or "The Land Fund" is mentioned or referred to the same shall be deemed and taken to mean the Consolidated Revenue Fund.
  - 8 This Act may be cited as "The Consolidated Revenue Fund Act."
