

AN ACT to further amend "The Cruelty to A.D. 1887. Animals Act, 1877." [20 December, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 The Governor in Council is hereby empowered from time to time Governor in to make, alter, and revoke Regulations for the purpose of preventing Council may cruelty to any animal while being landed from or taken on board any wessel, or being transported from place to place in Tasmania and any to prevent cruelty vessel, or being transported from place to place in Tasmania; and any to prevent to animals. such Regulations may prescribe penalties not exceeding Five Pounds for every offence against such Regulations. All such Regulations shall be published in the *Gazette*, and shall take effect from a date to be named therein, and after such date shall have the force of Law as if the same had been inserted in this Act.

2 "The Cruelty to Animals Act, 1877," and every Act amending Acts to be read the same, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. together.
