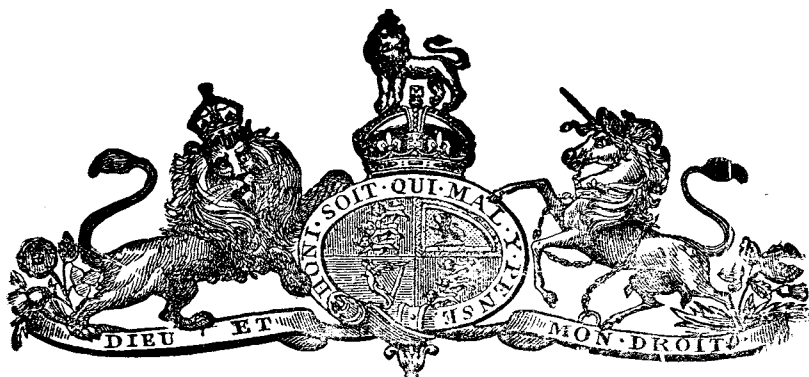

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Deletion of words in agreement and substitution of other words therefor.

AN ACT to amend "The Dunkley Brothers Limited Loan Act, 1918." [31 March, 1924.] A.D.
1924.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Dunkley Brothers Limited Loan Act, 1924." Short title.

2—(1) The words "Three years" occurring in Clause Five of the agreement dated the Eleventh day of March, One thousand nine hundred and nineteen, executed by the Minister for Lands and Works, in pursuance of "The Dunkley Brothers Limited Loan Act, 1918," are hereby deleted from the said agreement and the words "Six years" substituted therefor. Deletion of words in agreement and substitution of other words therefor.

(2) The said agreement shall be read and construed in all respects as if the substituted words had been originally inserted therein in place of the words hereby deleted.
