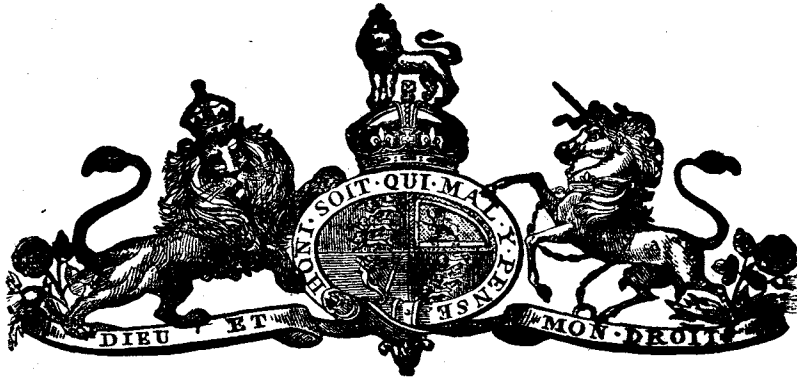

AN ACT to further amend "The District Justices Act," 1907," and for other purposes.  
[23 November, 1917.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The District Justices Amendment Act, 1917," and shall be read as one with "The District Justices Act, 1907."

**2** After Section Fifteen of "The District Justices Act, 1907," the following section is inserted :—

"**16** No clerk of Petty Sessions who is a justice shall, whilst holding the office of such clerk, perform any judicial act as a justice."

Clerks of Petty Sessions being justices not to act judicially.
