

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation with 7 Ed. VII. No. 36. 2. Clerks of Petty Sessions being justices not to act judicially.

AN ACT to further amend "The District 1917. Justices Act," 1907," and for other purposes. [23 November, 1917.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The District Justices Amendment Act, Short title and 1917," and shall be read as one with "The District Justices Act, incorporation with 1907."

2 After Section Fifteen of "The District Justices Act, 1907," Clerks of Petty the following section is inserted:—

"16 No clerk of Petty Sessions who is a justice shall, whilst holding the office of such clerk, perform any judicial act as a justice.

Sessions being justices not to act judicially.
