

AN ACT respecting the Department of A.D. Agriculture. [10] January, 1912.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 This Act may be cited as "The Department of Agriculture Act, Short title. 1911."

2 In this Act "the said Acts" means the Acts mentioned in the Interpretation, schedule hereto and all Acts which the Governor may specify from time to time, and includes all enactments passed, whether before or after the commencement of this Act, in amendment or substitution of such Acts or any of them, and also includes all regulations for the time being in force under any such Act or enactment.

Chief inspector, &c., to be subject to control of Director.

- 3—(1) The Director of Agriculture for the time being for this State—
 - I. Shall, under the Minister for the time being controlling the Department of Agriculture, administer the said Acts:
 - II. May from time to time equally with any chief inspector, inspector, or officer exercise all or any of the powers and authorities exercisable by or vested in any such chief inspector, inspector, or officer under or by virtue of the said Acts or any of them.
- (2) Every chief inspector, inspector, or officer for the time being appointed or acting under the said Acts or any of them shall, subject to the provisions of any Act for the time being in force regulating the Public Service of Tasmania, be under and subject to the control of the said Director of Agriculture.
