

AN ACT to further amend "The Depart-A.D. 1902 ment of Agriculture Act, 1897."

[20 December, 1902.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Department of Agriculture Short title. Amendment Act, 1902."
- 2 In this Act "the said Act" shall mean "The Department of Interpretation. Agriculture Act, 1897." 61 Vict. No. 7.
- 3 Section Ten of the said Act is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof Repeal and rethe following shall be and be deemed to be and may be cited as Section enactment of Sect. 10 of Sect. 1
- "10—(1.) The Council shall at its first meeting in each year elect cone of its number to be Chairman of the Council, and another of Chairman and the Chairman of the Council, and the Chairman Vice-Chairman and Vice-Chairman so elected shall hold office until the first meeting of

the Council in the succeeding year, or until their successors are appointed.

(2.) The Chairman when present shall preside at all meetings of the Council or the Executive Body thereof, and if he shall be absent from any such meeting, the Vice-Chairman shall preside.

(3.) In the event of both Chairman and Vice-Chairman being absent, the Council or Executive Body thereof shall appoint any other Member to act as Chairman at such meeting.

Amendment of Sect. 11 of 61 Vict. No. 7. 4 The words "other than the Minister" in the Second line, and the words "the Minister or" in the Sixth line, of Section Eleven of the said Act are hereby repealed.

Amendment of Sect. 13 of 61 Vict. No. 7. 5 The words "Governor in" in the Second line of Section Thirteen of the said Act are hereby repealed.

Amendment of Sects. 15 & 16 of "Minister" in the Second line thereof, and the Third and Fourth 61 Vict. No. 7.

Acts to be read together.

7 This Act and the said Act and every Act amending the same, save as altered or amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
